A: "I feel really good and excited because the other team we actually beat in the championship game was the team who came up with the idea for the tournament. So it feels good to beat those people."


Q: Did you and your team practice a lot?

Q: What are some of your hobbies?


A: "Well, I like to go camping, and I love learning how to cook


